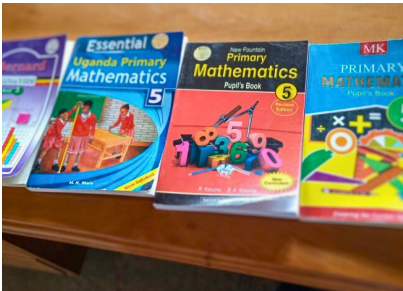
Education

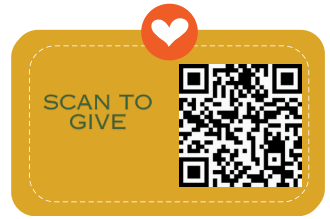
